
CALL TO SUPPORT THE MSCA POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIPS 2025 APPLICATIONS

CISPAC (Centro de Investigación Interuniversitario das Paisaxes Atlánticas Culturais - Interuniversity Research Centre for Atlantic Cultural Landscapes) is launching a call to support applications for the MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships 2025, with estimated publication and submission dates in April and September 2025, respectively. CISPAC is a unique new generation inter-university research centre, part of the Galician University System (SUG). Its mission is research on landscapes from a transdisciplinary perspective, in search of epistemic answers to contemporary challenges, to produce from knowledge, another way of observing and working the landscape, heritage and production, from identity, participation and sustainability.

The centre is organized around five major research fields that address questions, and are developed through projects, under the vocation of transdisciplinarity. A research centre designed to create new knowledge from an outstanding commitment to human capital, competitive research, social transfer of knowledge and the rendering of services.



Candidates must prepare a research proposal to be carried out during the fellowship within the framework of one of the 5 research fields included in CISPAC's scientific agenda, as well as the three strategic axes:

STRATEGIC AXES 2024-2027

Transition and change. Global warming, the sixth extinction, migrations, overcoming binarisms.

Gender and intersectionality. Critical analysis of the evolution of societies and territories, reinterpretations of the heritage and its material legacy

Sustainability. Balance between environmental and social issues. Sustainability not only as a technical solution, but also as a social, cultural and economic one.

What does the CENTRE offer to candidates who want to develop their MSCA?

- CISPAC offers a framework of excellence that is highly valued for the presentation of candidatures, highlighting its unique, inter-university character. In addition, in relation to the aspects evaluated, we can highlight the existence of a Gender Equality Policy in the centre.
- We also offer a **wide range of** <u>experts</u> who can perform the functions of supervising candidates in the different areas of work. Candidates can browse our website to identify potential supervisors or, alternatively, submit their application and the management team will search for a potential supervisor according to the proposed lines of research.
- In addition, it provides **academic support** in the preparation of applications, as well as for their management, through the international offices of each of the three universities that make up the centre (Santiago de Compostela, A Coruña and Vigo). In case the grant is awarded, advice will also be provided for the management of the grant.
- A wide range of ongoing **competitive research projects** with which grant recipients will be able to interact.
